Description of University Logo

The 'Crest' on the top is the emblem of the State of Karnataka. 'Gandhi Charaka' represents village artisanship, self-reliance and indigenous knowledge. The 'Ears of Corn' stand for green revolution, the growth of agriculture and prosperity. The 'Circle' at the heart of the logo signifies synergy of both human and rural development. 'Microscope' represents the research and development of Science and Technology; the 'Hood' and 'Certificate' signify graduation with best outcomes leading to employment and entrepreneurship opportunities for youth; 'Space Antenna' represents development of Information, Communication and Technology and the 'Bullock Cart' signifies agriculture and allied activities in rural areas. The 'Group of people' represents Gram Sabha (the soul of the Panchayat Raj system) and also participatory governance in rural local-self government institutions. The book on which 'Gram Swaraj' (Gandhian Ideology) scripted in Kannada signifies the overall development of rural areas and the people. The motto at the bottom 'Rural Roots Global Heights' makes one think globally and act locally. The abbreviation 'KSRDPRU' stands for Karnataka State Rural Development and Panchayat Raj University. Overall color of the logo is 'Green' signifies prosperity.
