ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION TO POSTGRADUATE COURSES.

Ref: 1. Proceedings of the Academic Council Meetings held on 06/08/2019.

2. Approval of Hon'ble Vice Chancellor dated 13/08/2019.

MA (Master of Arts), MSW (Master of Social Works), and MBA (Rural Management / Agribusiness Management)	Any graduate with a minimum of 50% (45% for SC / ST / Cat. I / Differently able candidates) of marks in the aggregate of all the subjects including languages is eligible. The eligibility criteria for MBA (Master of Business Administration) Course are as recommended by the Government of Karnataka from time to time.
M.A. Economics (Development Economics)	Any graduate with Economics as major or optional subject, with a minimum of 50% (45% for SC / ST / Cat. I / Differently abled candidates) of marks in the subjects at the degree is eligible.
M.Com. (Entrepreneurship / Cooperative Management)	B.Com. / BBA / BBM graduates with 50% (45% for SC / ST / Cat. I / DA candidates) of marks in the aggregate of all the subjects including Languages is eligible.
M.Sc. in Geoinformatics.	Any Science (including Farm Sciences) or Engineering graduate with a minimum of 50% (45% for SC / ST / Cat. I / DA candidates) of marks in the aggregate of all optional subjects is eligible. The order of preference is as follows: 1. Any Science or Engineering graduate who has studied Mathematics either at Degree or at PUC (10+2 level). 2. M.Sc. Geography Post-graduates. 3. Any graduate who has studied Geography as optional / Major subject at the degree level.
M.Sc. in Computer Science (Data Analytics)	B.Sc. Degree with Computer Science / BCA / BE / B.Tech. (any branch) or any Science Graduate with Mathematics / Statistics at 10+2 level with a minimum of 50% (45% for SC / ST / Cat. I / DA candidates) of marks in the aggregate of all optional subjects is eligible.
M.Sc. in Food Science & Technology	Any Science (including Farm Sciences) or Engineering graduate with a minimum of 50% (45% for SC / ST / Cat. I / DA candidates) marks in the aggregate of all the optional subjects, provided the candidate has studied Chemistry or Biochemistry and one of the Life Science subjects either at degree level or at PUC (10+2 level) is eligible.
MPH (Master of Public Health)	Any graduate with a minimum of 50% (45% for SC / ST / Cat. I / Differently able candidates) of marks in the aggregate of all the subjects including languages is eligible. But, the preference will be given to those who have experience in health field.

Note: In M.Sc. Geoinformatics Course 15 % of seats are earmarked for M.Sc. Post-graduates in Geography, Geology and Environmental Science. Hence they may also apply.
